# KING, KING GIVE A SOLDIER

**Goal of the game:** The team with the most players at the end wins.

**Game rules:** The children are divided into two groups with the same number of members. They stand opposite each other and hold hands. The starting team will say “King, king give a soldier. The other team answers “Which one?” The first team chooses and calls his/her name. The selected player runs and tries through the opponents hand. If successful he will take one of the players he has passed through to his team. If he was not successful he stays in the foreign team.

# BLIND MAN'S BUFF

You need: scarf

Number of players: 3 and more

**Game rules:** The children stand around blind man's buff which is standing between them with their eyes closed by a scarf. It rotates around its axis to lose orientation. **The children stand in a circle and ask:** Blind man's buff, what are you standing on? **Blind man's buff replies:** On a stick. **Children:** What do you have under it? **Blind man's buff:** Porridge with milk. **Children:** What do you want? The blind man's buff chooses a quiet, pinch, clapped or torn one. This means that children can clapp or pull her for clothes... Or they will be completely quiet. Whoever blind man's buff catches, she must identify him. Then this child becomes a blind man's buff. If she fails, the game continues.
