1ST GAME - MRÁZIK

◆ Rules:

- ◆ At the beginning of the game we choose „MRÁZIK“ (Mrázik – a person who catches the remaining players)
- ◆ Then „MRÁZIK“ counts to five and starts catching
- ◆ The one he catches has to stand with his legs spreaded and wait for someone to sneak under him (set him free) and continue the game
- ◆ „MRÁZIK“ wins when he catches all of the players.



2ND GAME – HIDE AND SEEK

◆ Rules:

- ◆ One kid is selected at the beginning of the game. Kid starts counting (usually up to 30) and the other players have to hide.
- ◆ When he counts, he can start looking for hidden players
- ◆ He wins if he finds all the players



◆ Examples of how not to play it:



3RD GAME – GULIČKY

◆ Rules:

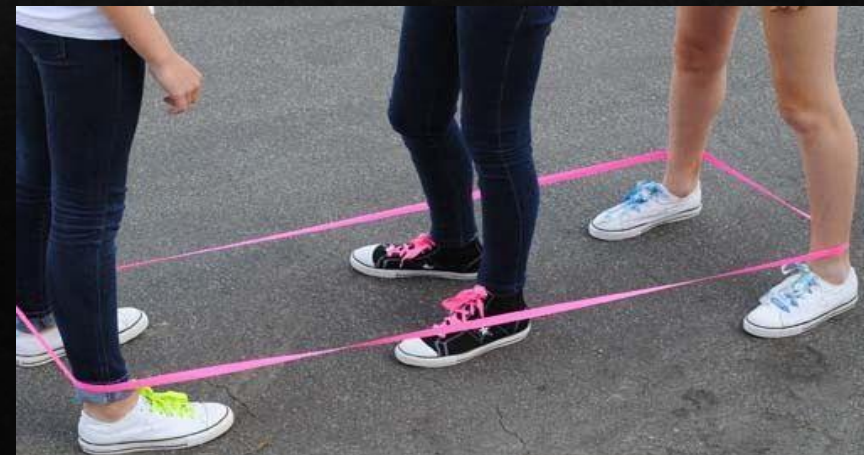
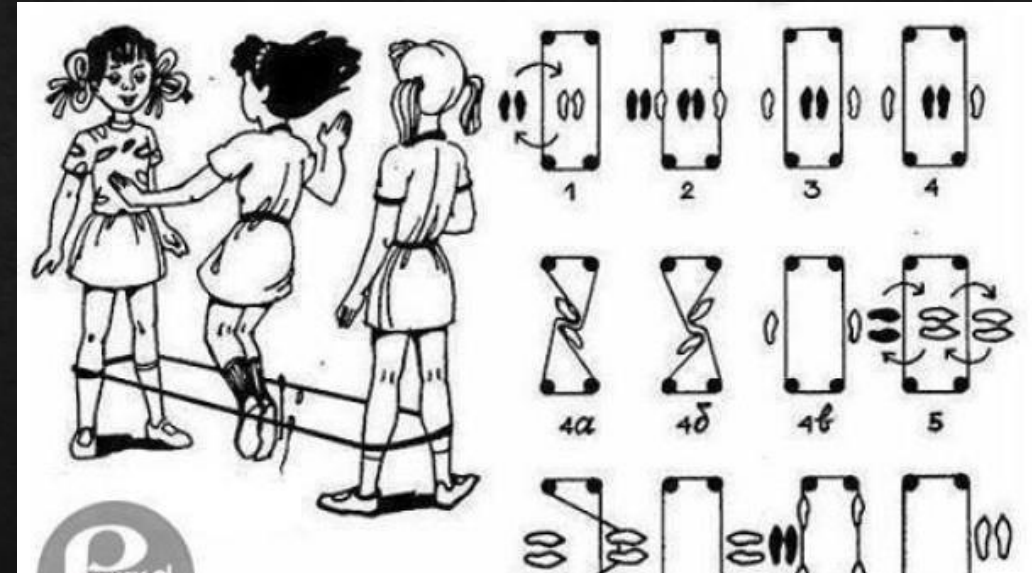
- ◆ Each player chooses 5 clay balls. They will make holes in the ground.
- ◆ The players take turns after one ball and try to hit the pit
- ◆ The winner is the player who hits all the balls into the hole as first



4TH GAME – GUMA

◆ Rules:

- ◆ The game is played by three players. Two players placed an bouncing rubber over the ankles and the third player is doing predetermined jump tricks.
- ◆ A player with no mistakes goes to the next level and the rubber is moved higher
- ◆ The winner is the player who passes all levels as first.
