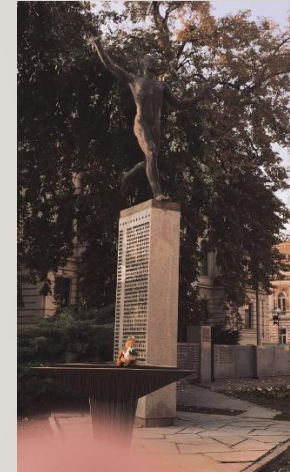
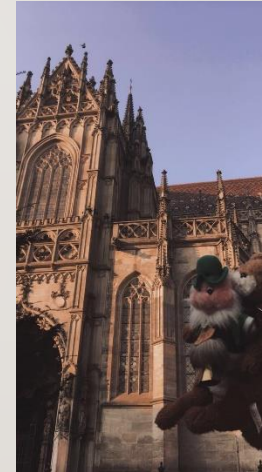


SOPHIE

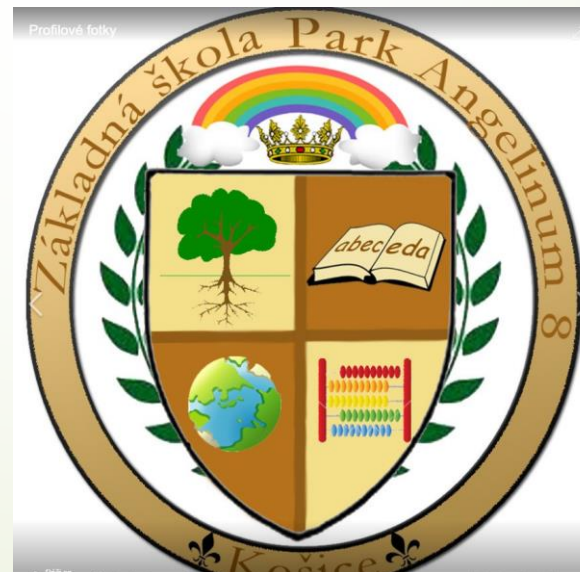

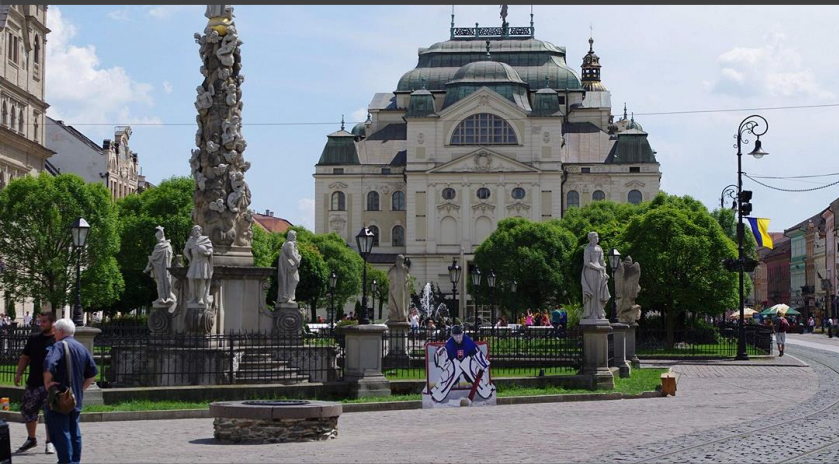

The Cathedral of St. Elizabeth

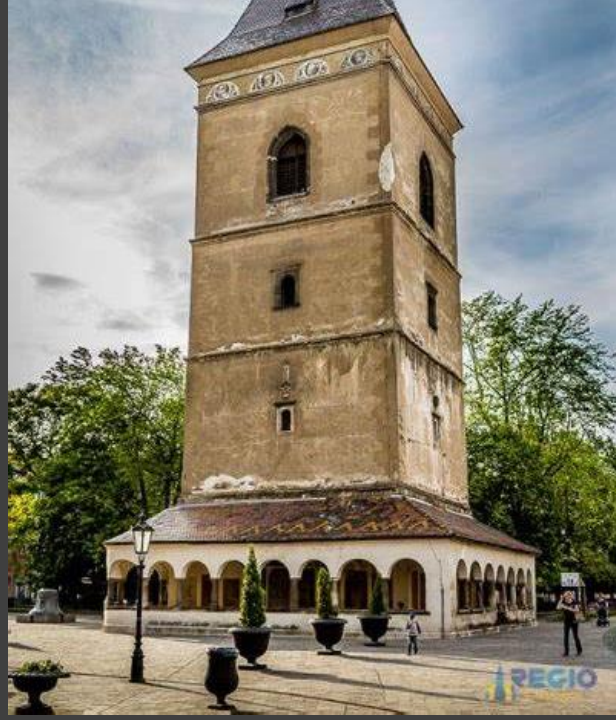
The biggest church in Slovakia

- The Grassalkovich palace is the residence of the president



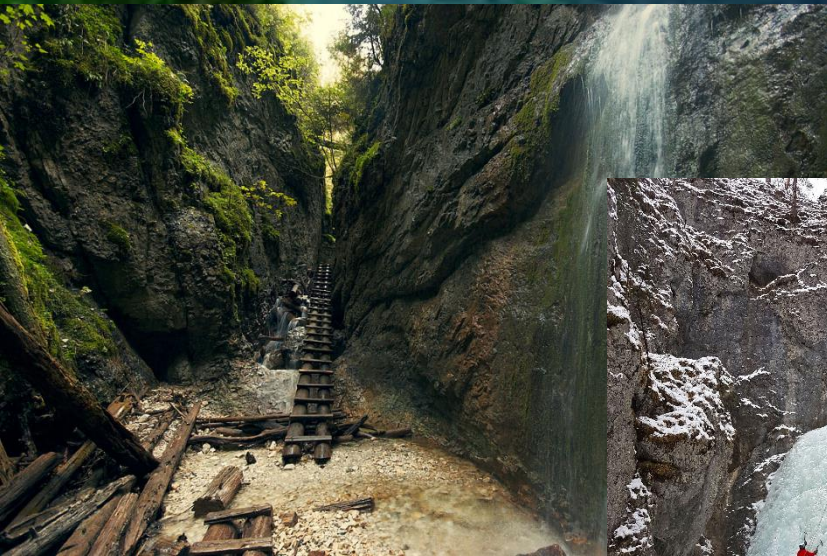

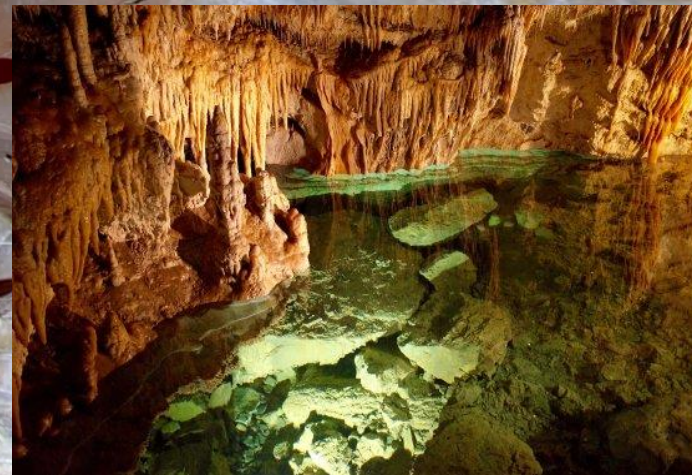
