This year we became the younger champions of Slovakia in water polo



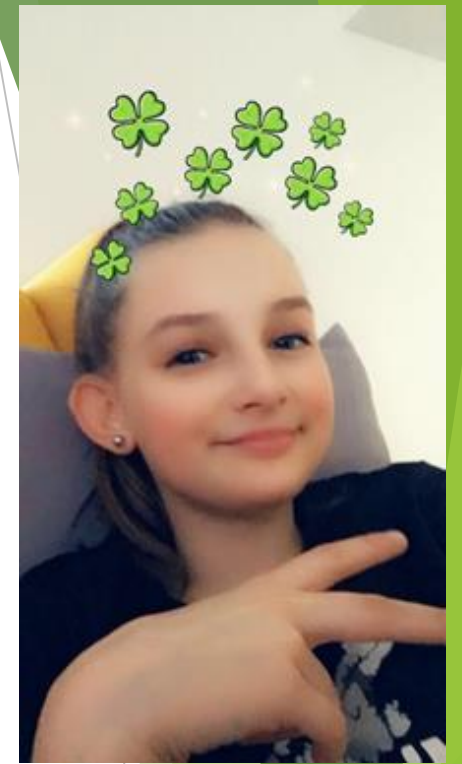
My name is Oliver

My name is **Mimi** and I am 12.

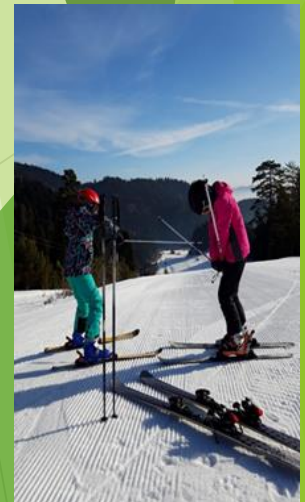
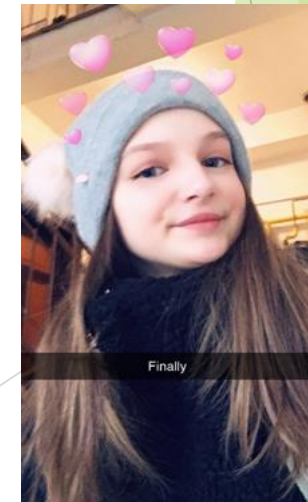
I have a younger sister Daniela. She is 9.

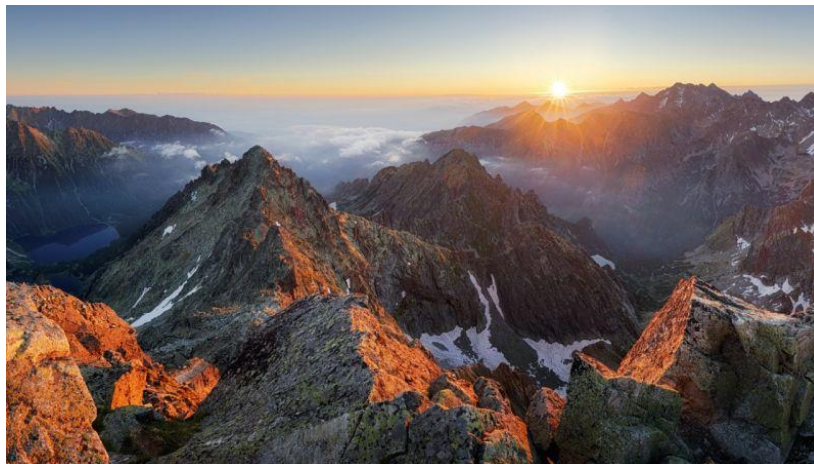
